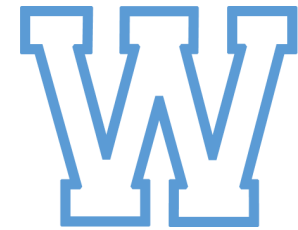
Bret Underwood is entering his seventh season as Head Baseball Coach and thirteenth overall at Wesley College. Under his guidance, Wesley set a single season school record for wins in 2012, along with coaching the Capitol Athletic Conference Player of the Year twice, Rob Benedict ('12) and Trey Mears ('17). The program has also defeated multiple nationally ranked teams during Underwood's tenure.

Bret was a four year starter at Delaware State University where he was a three time All-Conference selection and one of the most prolific hitters in school history. He ranks in the top three in hits, HR, RBI, runs, and extra base hits. After completing his senior season at Delaware State, Bret signed a free agent contract with the Boston Red Sox.

Trey Mears is entering his fourth summer with Wolverine Baseball Camps.
